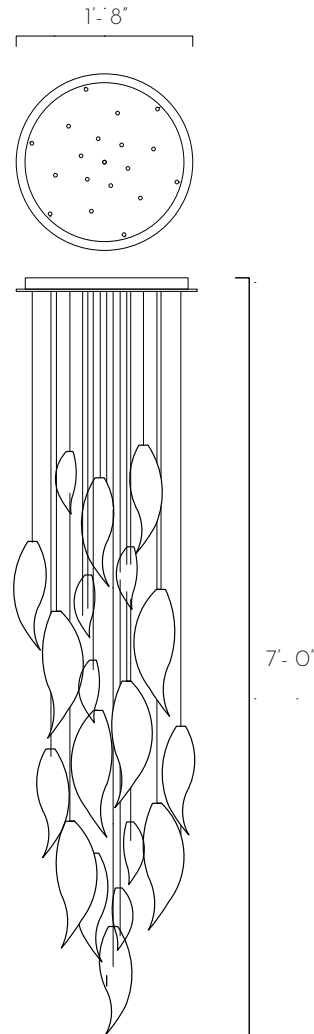


GLASS FLAMES

19 PENDENTS ROUND CHANDELIER



DESCRIPTION

The Glass Flames fixture is a hand-blown glass pendant chandelier designed by AM Studio and Canadian glass artist Karli Sears. Each pendant is hand-blown and finished in an opaque white, opalite, bronze and smoke finish. Perfect as a dining chandelier along the table, a staircase chandelier staggering down from the ceiling, or where an artistic light is needed.

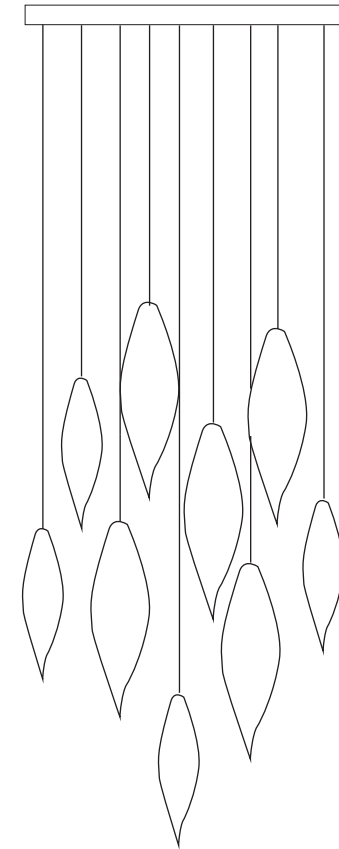
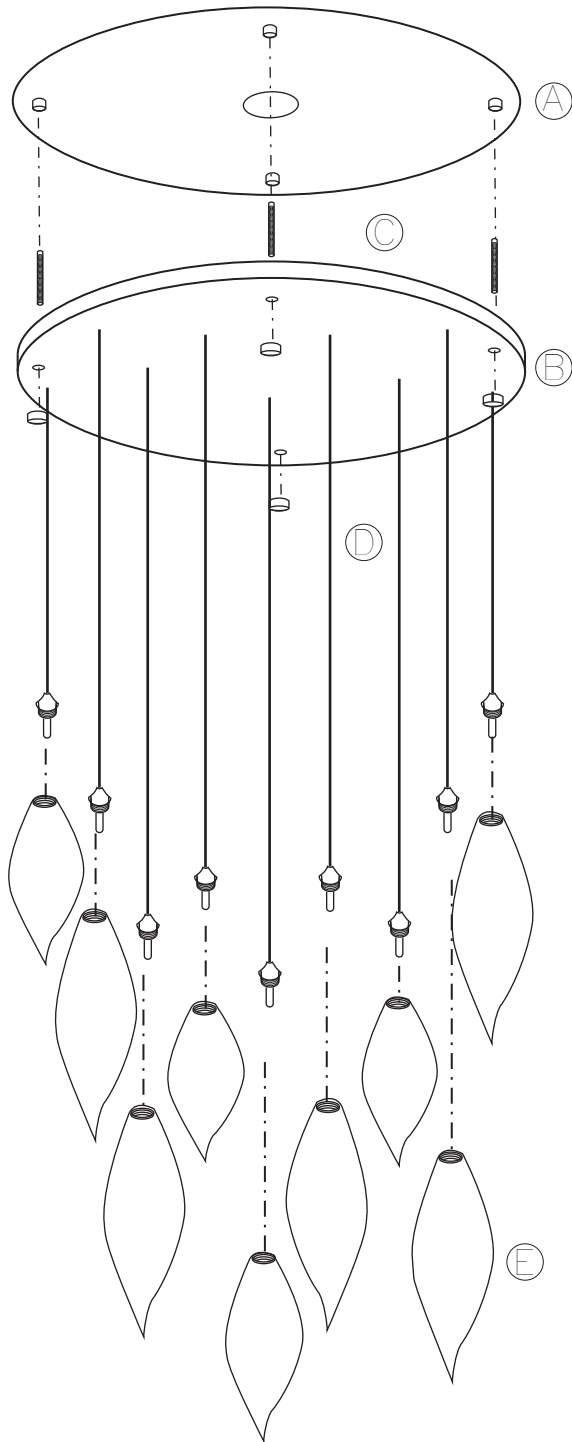

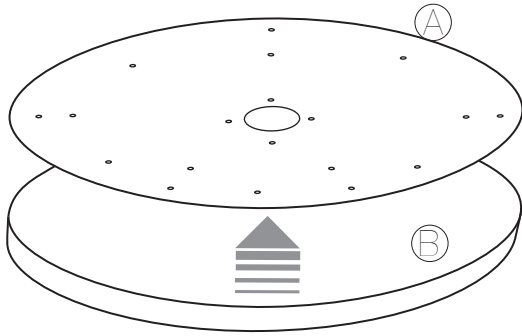
Glass Flames Assembly Guide



- Ⓐ x1 Bridge
- Ⓑ x1 Base
- Ⓒ x4 Support Rods (temporary mounting only)
- Ⓓ x4 Button Head Screws
- Ⓔ x4 Glass Pendants (three sizes)

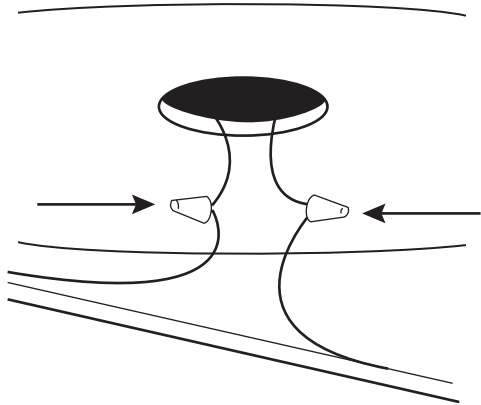

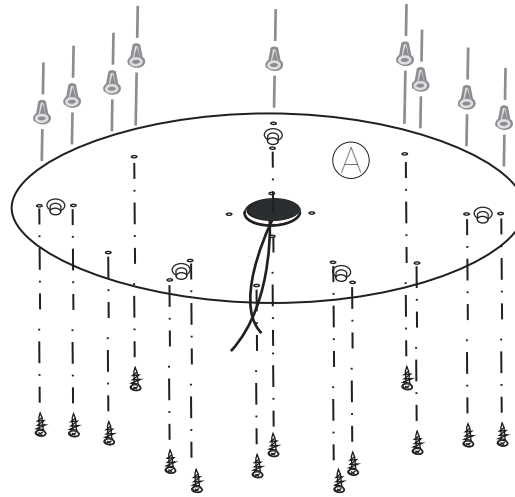
Separate (A) from (B)

Connect electrical wire to the power

2.



Mount (A) to the ceiling.

Note: When mounting be sure to locate and mount (A) to a joist/ceiling beam

If you cannot do so, be sure to use drywall screws and anchors, drill additional holes for mounting for better support

Test lights by turning on power

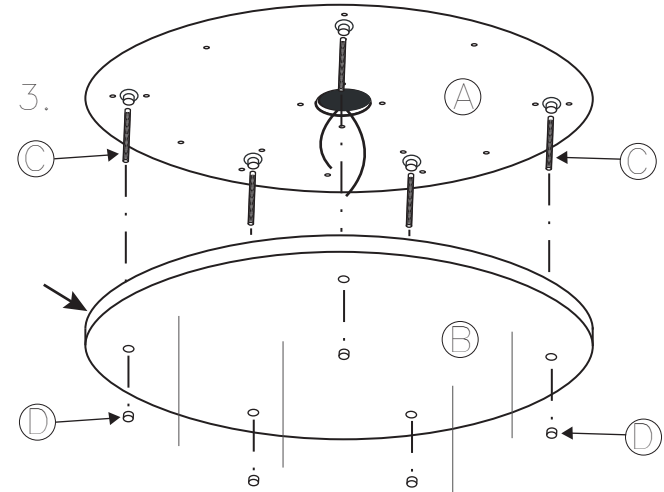


Make sure bulb is not touching the glass!

Turn off power after testing

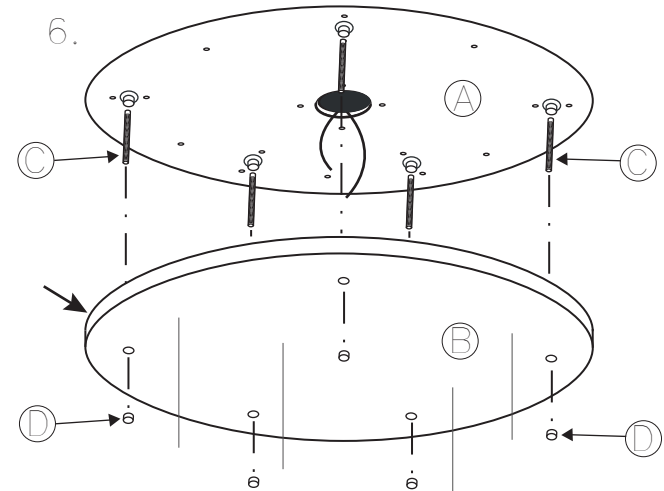

Use support rods (C) provided to hang (B) off of (A)

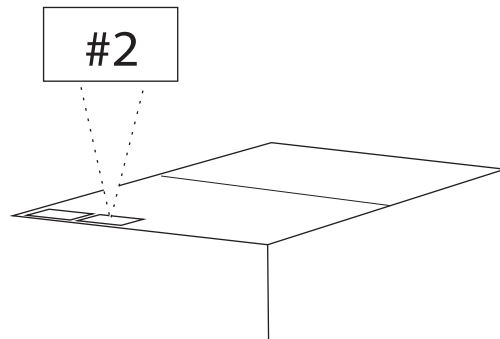
Complete attachment with button head screws (D)

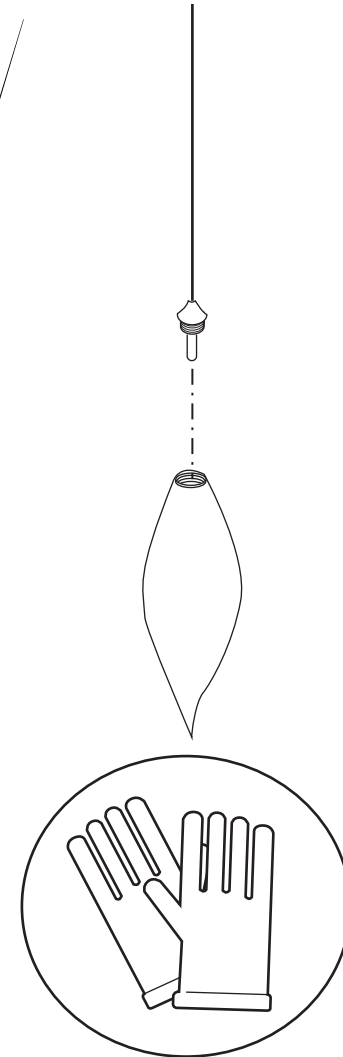
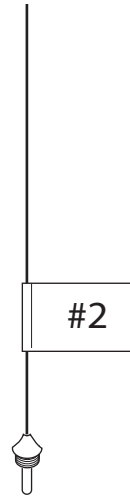


Remove rods and attach (B) to (A) with the button head screws (D)

Attach pednants to cables by
matching thier stickers



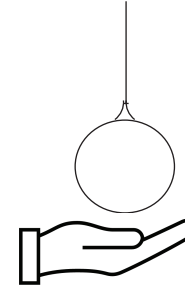
Always use gloves when handling

1.



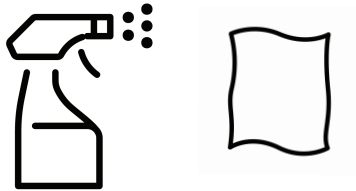
- Dust the cord/rope/chain with a duster.

2.



- Hold the glass pendant/light fixture and gently wipe with a duster or microfiber cloth to remove dust.

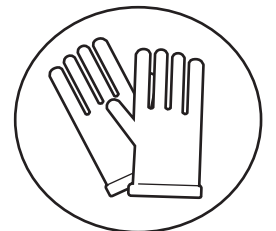


- For spot cleaning, use any good glass cleaner and a microfiber cloth.
- ⚠ Do **NOT** spray directly onto the light fixture/ glass pendant

- Finish by gently wiping down the pendant with a soft, dry microfibre cloth.



Always use gloves when
